

Sierra Road Recent Improvements

(Based on Requests from Residents)

- Installed new Neighborhood Watch signs on Sierra Road and Skyview Drive
- Installed new Type P object markers (yellow and black diagonal stripe signs) at driveway for 3585 and 3595 Sierra Road
- Installed new delineators on the shoulder areas as part of the current pilot program
- Added intersection striping and marking enhancements at Sierra Road and Skyview Drive
- Replaced all “No Parking” signs with “No Stopping” signs
- Installed additional “No Stopping” at several locations on Sierra Road
- Based on community request, All-way stop warrant study was conducted. All-way stops are not warranted at this time.

Proposed Improvements

- Sierra Road Engineering and Traffic Study (ETS) is complete. Based on results, speed reduction from 30 mph to 25 mph speed limit is warranted. The reduced speed limit zone from 0.15 miles southeast of Skyview Drive to 0.75 miles northeast of Skyview Drive. ETS will need concurrence from City of San Jose and California Highway Patrol. Planned for BOS approval in March 2021. Remaining sections of Sierra Road will have no posted speed limit.
- Install rumble strips as pilot program on Sierra Road, if consensus from impacted residents achieved.
- Installation of safety light (streetlight) at Sierra Road/Skyview Drive.
- Installation of flashing beacons on Sierra Road at Skyview Drive intersection.
- Expand delineators at other locations on Sierra Road after successful completion of current pilot program.
