<p><i>Block Party</i></p> <p>A festive gathering of a neighborhood which is stationary and requires road closure or restricts the general use of the road.</p> <p>(Application is due not less than 15 calendar days before the block party.)</p>	<p>\$98</p>
<p><i>Minor Special Event</i></p> <p>A special event on a road involving fewer than 500 people that does not comply with normal or usual traffic regulations or controls; or a special event on a road involving fewer than 500 people that requires the placement of a tent, canopy, or other temporary structure on the road.</p> <p>(Application is due not less than 30 calendar days before the event.)</p>	<p>\$200</p>
<p><i>Expressive Activity/March/Demonstration</i></p> <p>A special event where the sole purpose is to express, disseminate, or communicate by verbal, visual, literary, or auditory means of opinion, views or ideas.</p> <p>(Application is due not less than 7 calendar days before the event.)</p>	<p>\$200</p>
<p><i>Major Special Event</i></p> <p>A special event which requires temporary closure of a road or portion thereof; or any special event involving 500 or more people.</p> <p>(Application is due not less than 60 calendar days before the event.)</p>	<p>Actual costs incurred by the Roads and Airports Department; the total will be determined upon completion of the permit.</p> <p><u>Your application will be processed upon payment of a \$1,000.00 deposit.</u> Fees may be paid in person or mailed to:</p> <p>Special Events Permit 101 Skyport Drive San Jose, CA 95110 Make checks payable to Santa Clara County</p>
